Details of processing activity:

PURPOSE OF PROCESSING ACTIVITY:

We process your personal data to answer your inquiries, to inform you about our services or to otherwise communicate with you via the usual communication channels (e.g. e-mail, post, telephone, fax).

LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING ACTIVITY:

The processing is necessary for the fulfilment of a pre-contractual measure pursuant to Art. 6(1)lit. b DS-GVO or to safeguard our legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 (1)lit. f DS-GVO and no interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject prevail.

CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS:

Furthermore, we use service providers (including processors) to perform our tasks, such as tax consultants, IT service providers and hosting providers, and transfer data to authorities or courts within the scope of legal obligations.

Additional Obligations to Provision of Information:

DURATION OF STORAGE OF PERSONAL DATA:

Personal data is deleted as soon as its purpose has ceased to exist and there is no obligation to retain it. E-mails are classified in principle as tax-relevant document and kept according to the legal handicaps in particular § 147 AO (10 years) and § 257 HGB (6 years).

RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS:

You have a right to information (in acc. with Art. 15 GDPR) from the controller on the personal data concerning you and to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR), deletion (Art. 17 GDPR), and to limitation of processing (Art. 18, Para.1 GDPR). You also have a right of objection to such processing (Art. 21 GDPR) and the right of data-portability (Art. 20 GDPR).

RIGHT TO COMPLAINT:

You have the right to complain to the responsible supervisory authority.
